2017 Northwestern Youth Tackle Football Info Sheet - Grades 4th, 5th, 6th

<u>League:</u> We will again be playing in the Wayne County Youth Instructional Football League (WCYIFL) with Orrville, Waynedale, Dalton, and Triway for the 2017 season. Students in grades 4^{th} , 5^{th} , and 6^{th} are eligible to participate for Northwestern and are separated into either a Lower Division team or Upper Division team based on grade and weight. Depending on the number of teams in the league, we might also possibly play some games with Wooster Youth Football.

<u>Sign Up, Payment, and Equipment:</u> You can send your registration and payment in to the address on the form or bring compelted form to Sign up day on Saturday July 29th from 8 AM – 11 AM behind the high school at the football practice field. All players will be given his / her equipment, weighed, and must pay the sign-up fee of \$90.00 if they haven't done so yet. Checks can be made payable to Husky Football Club. Any checks returned to us from the bankfor NSF will be charged an additional \$30 bank fee. Players that cannot be there July 29th can come early to the first night of practice to be signed up.

Practices:

- Practice will begin on Monday, July 31 from 6PM to 8PM on the field in front of the Junior High by the Varsity baseball field.
- We will practice on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays from 6 PM to 8PM until the first week of school. You will need only your helmet and mouth piece only the first week of practice. Also bring your own water bottle.
- Starting the week of August 21st we will begin our normal practice schedule of Monday and Wednesday nights from 6PM to 8PM.
- Practices times will be moved up later in the season as it starts to get dark earlier.
- <u>Labor Day / Fair Day Practice Move:</u> Because of Labor Day and Kids Day at the Fair on Monday 9/4 and Monday 9/11 there will be no practice. Practice will be moved to Tuesday 9/5 and Tuesday 9/12.
- Missed Practices-You are required to attend all practices. Missing a practice will result in the loss of playing time at games. If you are too sick to come or there is a conflict you must call. Simply attending the Fair is not an excuse for not coming to practice. You must be showing an animal or selling to be excused.

Game Schedules:

- All games will be played on Saturday's beginning September 16th. Start times will vary.
- We play the following Saturday's -9/16, 9/23, 9/30, 10/7, 10/14, 10/21.
- Schedules will be given out later with times. Game times and locations will vary and rotate between Northwestern, Orrville, Waynedale, Dalton, Wooster. There is a \$2 admission charge for games played at Wooster.
- We will also schedule some scrimmages in August with times and locations TBD.

Meet The Team Night: Monday August 7th

- Meet The Team Night is a fun evening that the Northwestern Football Club puts on to showcase the football teams.
- Players will participate in a Punt / Pass / Kick A Thon beginning around 5:00 PM.
- Player introductions will follow this.
- The youth football players are asked to bring a donation of at least a 12 pack of water/soda for the evening. Please bring it to any one of the practices prior to August 7th.

Youth Night: Friday September 29th at the High School. Our Youth Players will get introduced prior to the Varsity game.

<u>Picture Day:</u> Wed Sept 6th prior to practice. Pictures will be done by Marty's Studios this year. We will pass out picture forms closer to this date.

<u>Mouth Guards:</u> Players are required to wear a mouth guard at practice and at games. Northwestern Youth Football will provide one mouth guard. If you lose or forget to bring yours, you will be charged \$1.00 for a new one.

Sportsmanship: The Northwestern Youth Football Board sets high expectations for our coaches. In turn, our coaches expect the same from their players. Bad sportsmanship will not be tolerated at practices or at games. We also ask that parents set a good example for our players. Just like in any other level of football, you will be asked to leave a game or practice due to your actions.
