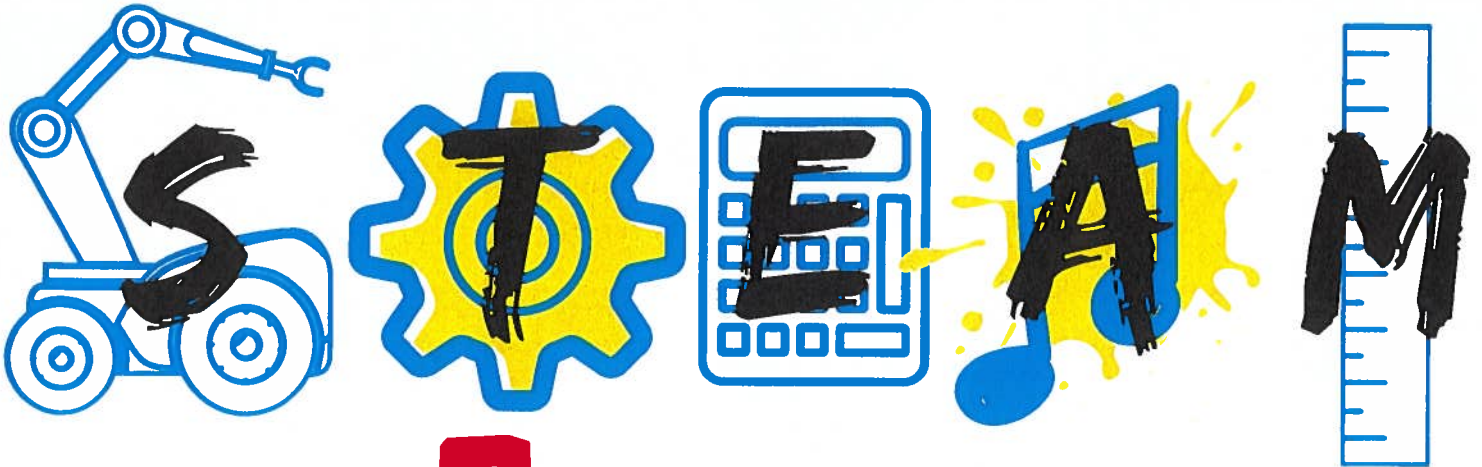

# Details and FAQs

## What is the Tri-County STEAM Summer Camp?

The Tri-County STEAM Summer Camp is an engaging multi-day daily camp designed for students in grades 3 - 8. Throughout the course of this camp, students will learn principles of design and engineering to create a remote powered robot using a VEX IQ kit. Students will work and collaborate safely to complete challenges testing students' designs, engineering, and skill.

## Who can participate in the camp?

The camp is open to any 3rd through 8th grader in Wayne, Holmes, or Ashland county. However, space is very limited, so register today to reserve your spot!

## How much does it cost?

The cost of this camp can vary from year to year, but because of the generosity of the Wayne Economic Development Council, we are able to offer the camp for the following cost:

## What will I learn about?
